Each Friday, Food for Thought will again be delivering backpacks to our students who qualify for free or reduced lunch and have signed up for Food for Thought services. Please have your child return the emptied backpack to the provided container in the multi-purpose room on Monday morning. Please remind your child that their food backpack should remain closed on the bus ride home.



- Remember, school breakfast and lunch are no longer automatically free for all students. You may go to the Walton County School District website to complete an application or pick up a paper application at the school.
- To access school menus online, visit the Walton County School District website, and select Food & Nutrition Services. Scroll down to the blue “Meal Viewer” icon and click on MSE. The menu is subject to change due to availability.
- Cost for a second milk at lunchtime is 50 cents. Students can either pay at time of purchase or parents can put money on lunch account in advance.



Transportation Information

- Student drop-off is from 7:15-7:45. Please utilize the drop-off line on John Baldwin Road and exit on the North end of the building. Students may not be dropped off at the front office unless tardy. If tardy (after 7:50), an adult must sign the child in.*
- Pick-Up dismissal begins at 2:25 each day. Please hang your current pick-up tag (red) from the rear-view mirror and remain in your car in the pick-up line on John Baldwin Road. If you arrive after 3:00, you will need to pick up your child in the front office with photo identification.*
- Bus dismissal begins at 2:25 each day. Please send a dated note if there are any transportation changes. Notes should include the child's first and last name, bus number, animal, and/or driver name, and **include the address** where you would like them dropped off.*
